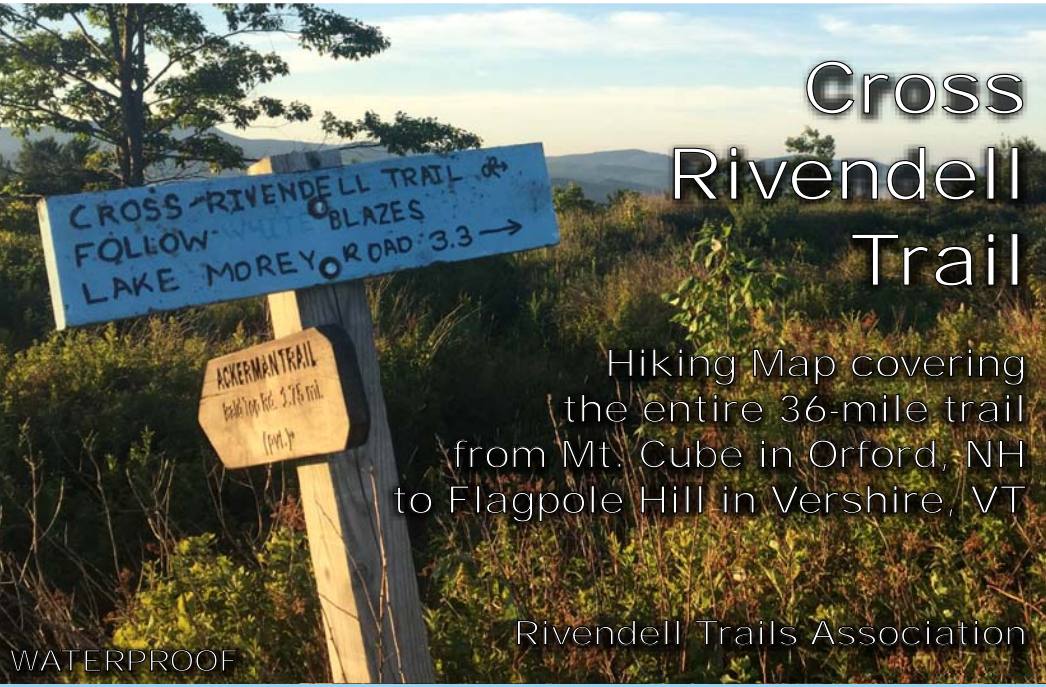


The Cross Rivendell Trail uses this blue blaze to mark the trail.

The Cross-Rivendell Trail is a community supported and maintained trail connecting the three schools of the Rivendell Interstate School with the towns of Orford, NH and Fairlee, West Fairlee, and Vershire, VT. As you travel along its 36 mile stretch you will see breathtaking mountain views, pass beside gurgling mountain streams, immerse yourself in dense forests, and bask in the tranquility of pristine wetlands.

Guidelines for Backcountry Recreation on the Cross-Rivendell Trail

- 1. Know what to expect:** Prepare for a change in weather and know the regulations for the trail. Carry enough food and water for your hike and be prepared for emergencies
- 2. Stay on the trail:** Hike on established trails to reduce erosion. Camping is not permitted along the trail except in designated areas, such as Southworth Park, where prior permission is required. Contact the Rivendell Trails Association (rivendelltrail@rivendellstudent.org) for camping/lodging info.
- 3. Take only pictures, leave only footprints:** Pack out all trash including food waste. Bury human waste in catholes 6 inches deep and cover. Leave stone walls intact. Leave unique objects for others to enjoy.
- 4. Fires:** The RTA prohibits fires on the Cross Rivendell Trail
- 5. Respect Wildlife:** Do not feed wildlife and give wild animals space. Keep pets under control.
- 6. Respect other hikers and landowners:** Keep your group size below 20. Speak softly and listen to nature's sounds. Park only where permitted and obey posted signs.



P₉ Cross Rivendell Trail WEST from Rivendell Academy to Lake Morey Rd.: The trail is unmarked and follows road 3.1 miles from Rivendell Academy in Orford, NH to Lake Morey Rd in Fairlee, VT. From EAST to WEST take Route 10 N followed by a left turn onto VT Route 25A crossing the bridge over the Connecticut River. In Fairlee, VT follow Route 5 S before turning right onto Lake Morey Rd.

P₁₀ Norris Road: Parking Area along Norris Road off of Archertown Rd. Trail leaves from here to EAST and Sunday Mountain. Heading WEST the trail follows roads and is unmarked from Norris Road to Town Shed Rd. Look for the trail entering the woods on the west side of Town Shed Road.

P₁₁ Dame Hill Road: Parking Area and information kiosk. Dame Hill Rd just off of Route 25A. To reach trail WEST walk north on Indian Pond Rd. and look for trailhead on west side of road. To reach trail EAST look for the trailhead going south, and on the opposite side, of Route 25A. Please remain aware of traffic.

P₁₂ Baker Road: Parking Area and information kiosk. Parking along the west side of the road. Trail to EAST proceeds uphill to summit of Mount Cube and the intersection with the Appalachian Trail. Trail to the West is found on Baker Rd heading back towards Route 25A.
